ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Only purebred Basenjis one year of age or older on the day of the Trial may be entered. All entries shall be individually registered with the AKC, the Federation Cynologique International, or an ASFA-recognized foreign or ASFA Board approved registry. Monorchid, cryptorchid, spayed, or neutered hounds may be entered.

CLASSES OFFERED

Test/Junior Courser Open to all eligible basenjis. A hound running alone shall receive a certification from a judge on one date and a 2nd certification from a different judge on a later date, indicating that the hound completed a 600- yard course with a minimum of four turns. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption. It is recommended that Junior Courser hounds entering the open stake for the first time have successful practice experience with other hounds before competing.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

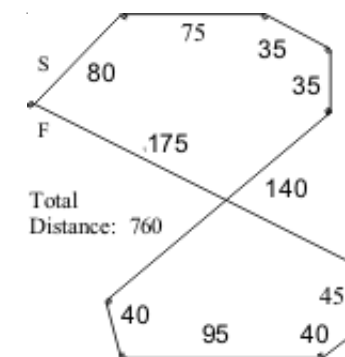
Entries will NOT be acknowledged by mail, email or telephone. Late, incomplete, conditional or unsigned entries will NOT be accepted. Hounds not present at roll call will be scratched. A fee of \$25.00 will be assessed for any returned checks.

Bitches in season, hounds with breed disqualifications, and lame hounds will be excused. Muzzles are not required. It is the responsibility of the owner to determine if their hound needs to be muzzled.

Battery powered continuous loop lure machines with back up equipment will be used. The lure will consist of highly visible plastic strips. Course will be reversed for finals.

The club reserves the right to alter the course plan the day of the trial due to weather and/or field conditions. There will be a \$5.00 fine assessed to the owner/handler rehurfor every incident of a loose hound on the field not taking part in the course in progress. Owners must keep their hounds under control and clean up after them at all times. Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to AKC, BCOA, any hound(s), or other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site.

SITE & EVENT SPECIFIC INFORMATION

The site is a gently rolling green lawn adjacent to the specialty site.

We've ordered perfect sunny weather, moderate temperatures with a gentle breeze. However, do plan for any weather condition. Field Events are held rain or shine.

Shade and seating are not provided for exhibitors. Do plan on bringing your own shade and seating.

AKC rules will be honored for their respective events. Please be familiar with the rules by going to www.akc.org to print or order rule books as needed.

Please maintain our site and pick up after your dogs. Also we request that you help maintain our site & pick up trash and dispose of such properly

Bitches in Season should not be brought on or near the field until AFTER the last event of the day is completed.

For the safety of your children, please be attentive to them and their activities as well as activities on the field.

If you have a desire to help with the event, please feel welcome to see a member of the field committee. Many hands make light work for all. We always have a need for assistance from those willing to learn something new.

IMPORTANT: Please be aware that the September temperature in Texas is still in the high 80s and 90s. Before entering the lure coursing trial or racing event, be sure that your hound is in top running condition and able to recover quickly after running hard in the heat. There will be water available for the hounds to be cooled in, but an overweight or out of condition hound could be put in a life threatening condition if it is running or racing in the heat. It is our desire to keep all hounds safe and sound, but it is up to you to determine if your hound is conditioned properly and able to handle running in the heat.
