ELIGIBILITY: All entries must be registered with LGRA. The basenjies must be individually registered with a recognized registry for purebred Gazeounds in order to register with LGRA. All entries shall be individually registered with American Kennel Club (AKC), Canadian Kennel Club (CKC), United Kennel Club (UKC), or any recognized foreign registry for purebred progeny of Gazehound breeds. Basenjies registered with the AKC under Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) or the CKC equivalent may also be registered.

Entries will not be acknowledged by mail. DO NOT BRING BITCHES IN SEASON TO THE MEET

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- ◆ Only basenjis that have previously raced in LGRA, NOTRA or CARA are eligible to enter. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- ◆ Entries with no racing or box experience will not be accepted.
- ◆ Basenjis must be registered with LGRA.
- ◆ Basenjis will run muzzled and jacketed. A limited number of each will be available; you are strongly encouraged to bring your own equipment if at all possible.
- ◆ The method of start will be boxes.
- ◆ The basenjis will run 200 yards straight after a lure consisting of fur and a squawker. Up to four basenjis race a total of three times, called programs. Depending on the order of finish, they may attain National points toward a GRC or SGRC, Gazehound Racing Champion or Superior Gazehound Racing Champion.
- ◆ Basenjis must be 1 year of age or older on the day of the trial.
- ◆ Bitches in season, hounds with breed disqualifications, and lame hounds at roll call will be excused (with entry fee refunded).
- ◆ Basenjis not present at roll call will be scratched.
- ◆ Spayed or neutered basenjis are eligible to participate.
- ◆ Battery-powered lure machines will be used.
- ◆ Lures will consist of fake fur and a squawker.
- ◆ A \$5.00 fine will be assessed the owner or handler of any hound loose on the field but not competing in the course in progress (this will be enforced).
- ◆ Any person may, upon reasonable complaint, be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Race Meet Committee.
- ◆ Children MUST be under control of their parent(s) or guardian(s).
