BALLOT NO. 9 - 12/5/83 - PASSED

UBJECT: TRANSFER OF FUNDS, circulated at the request of President Camp

Your approval is requested for the transfer of \$1,000 from the BCOA savings account to the National Specialty savings account, which will be sent to the Assistant Treasurer for 1984 National Specialty expenses.

NOTE: Due to net losses of 1982 and 1983 specialties, and \$330.98 having been sent for 1984 specialty, there is currently a balance of only \$3.48 in the National Specialty savings account. However, approximately \$800 will be arriving from the 1983 National Specialty Chairman in a week or so, and fund-raising projects are planned by the 1984 National Specialty committee.

NO RECORD OF VOTE: Jiminez, Mankey, Zaretsky

\*Camp Comment: I was told wrong on the \$330.89. \$165.89 went to the '84 site/judges committee, \$165.00 to the '85 site/judges committee (same amount, just different specialty). It is in hope that fund-raising projects will soon start for the '84 National so they will be able to repay the BCOA the \$165.98 and the \$1,000 if this is approved, so that '85 might have some money for their specialty.

\*\*Kelley Comment: If '82 and '83 didn't make money, where is the \$800 from '83 coming from? I don't really understand how '83 could have been unprofitable.

\*\*\*Russell Comment: I am glad that the 1984 committee is doing some fund-raising. I feel very strongly that BCOA should not be expected to cover all front money needed. There is plenty of time for garage sales, etc., to make money. I am very concerned that there is a trend toward losing money on national specialties.

\*\*\*\*Hauri Comment: For 1983 we have paid out \$1,631.90 and received nothing back yet. I feel that since we have already paid \$330.98 that we should deduct that amount from the \$1,000. In the past \$500 was all that we send for "seed" money and right now it looks like the 1983 specialty is only going to be able to pay for one judge and the BCOA is going to have to pay the other judge, all the mailings, etc., even though we had the biggest entry ever. At this rate we will be bankrupt in about three years!
