Responsibility for the physical publication (assembly, layout, printing, and distribution) shall be that of the *Roster* Editor, who shall be approved each year by the Board. The *Roster* shall be printed and distributed at the earliest date feasible in the Club year. A copy of the *Roster* shall be provided to each club member (one copy per family unit) in good standing, and to each new member or family unit voted into membership during the Club year. The *Roster* shall contain:

- Names of all members in good standing as of the date of publication, including (as applicable): Address; phone number and one (1) other number (E-Mail or FAX); Kennel name; Code for puppies, adults, and stud service availability; Code for colors available; Affiliated club(s); Rescue
- Separate listing of Officers and Board of Directors, with addresses and phone numbers
- Separate listing of Lifetime Members
- Names and addresses of publication editors
- Paid advertising, by members in good standing

The member so appointed shall utilize his/her own computer and such other equipment as shall be necessary for this function. Server space may be rented from an on-line Internet provider. The cost of such provider service shall be subject to Board approval.

The member approved for this position shall provide *only*:

- Material approved by the Board (Standard, Code of Recommended Practices; Basenji Health Sheet, Bibliography, etc.)
- Material provided by Board-approved committees, tallies, etc.
- Material printed in BCOA publications (such as tallies, published "events" information, geographical listing of rescue contacts, affiliated clubs, etc.)
- Any other material that may be approved by the Board.

Additionally:

- All inquiries shall be referred to the appropriate person or committee (Breeder Referrals, Rescue contacts, Membership, Tallies, etc.) by phone number and E-mail address (where available). Because the Internet is very public in nature, due care shall be taken that referrals are BCOA-related, and that the person or committee to whom inquiries are referred receives no unwarranted solicitations or mail.

1995 update: Airline Transportation by Priscilla Benkin may be obtained for \$1 from the American Dog Owners Association, 1654 Columbia Turnpike, Castleton, NY 12033. It tells what airlines have what regulations and gives excellent ideas

on how to safely ship your dog by air, such as adding lock washers between the nuts and bolts of a Vari-Kennel crate so they won't loosen during the flight. They also recommend putting a bungee cord across the Vari-Kennel door to hold it shut in case the kennel be dropped or jolted. ☺

## Rescue

### RESCUE-LISTING POLICY

**WHO CAN LIST** — Basenjis listed with, or turned over to, rescue contacts or organizations by owners having no other place to turn; by shelters; by animal control officers or by humane societies.

**LISTING INFORMATION** — Send name/s of Basenjis, vital statistics, good/bad traits, whether crate-trained, medical information, type of home desired and (optional) snapshot to: **The Bulletin Board**, 341 N. Billerica Road, Tewksbury, MA 01876 (call/FAX Betsy Polglase: (508) 458-8108). The dog will be listed until it is adopted, or for three issues of the *Bulletin Board Newsletter*—whichever comes first.

**ADOPTION FEE** — An adoption fee probably will be requested by the rescue contact or organization. The fee is to help offset rescue expenses such as: spaying or neutering; updating shots; testing for worms (or worming); testing for heartworm; strip-testing Basenjis over age 3 for presence of Fanconi Syndrome; or such extra expenses as advertising, boarding, or additional medical expenses incurred on behalf of the Basenji.

Note: If the adoptor is charged the full adoption fee, which most often is in the range of \$90 to \$150, he or she should expect most of these items to have been taken care of before adopting the dog (actually quite a bargain if you check with current veterinarian prices).

**"HAPPY ENDINGS"** — *Let us know of your "happy endings!"* — these encourage others to adopt.
