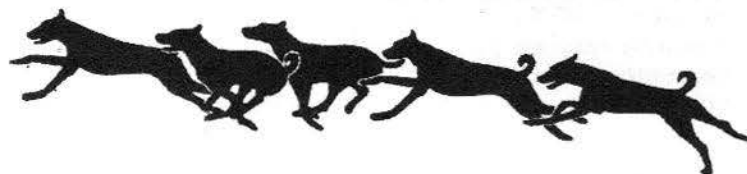

This committee is comprised a group of people who will provide various levels of expertise leaving the club/host group free to concentrate their efforts at the local level. 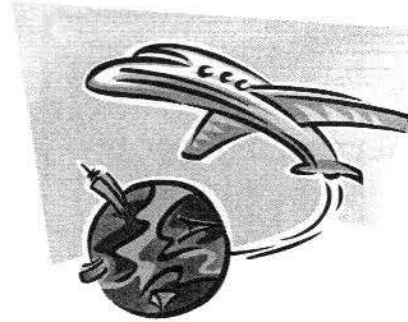

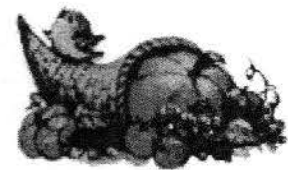

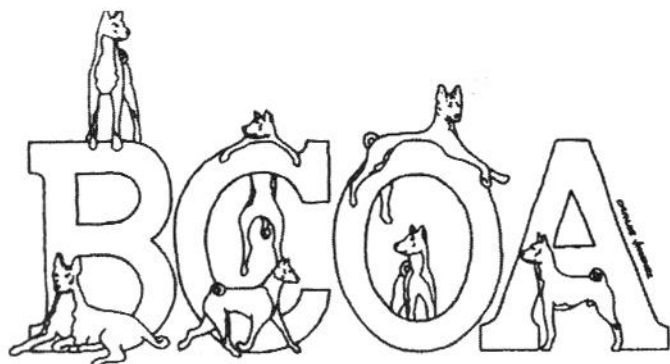
