## **AKC Approved Basenji Judge -- Linda Scanlon on September 29, 2010**

Obviously a basenji! Lovely muzzle to back skull proportions, small ears placed well on skull, hooded when alert. Wrinkle showing when ears up. Well placed, properly shaped eyes, brown blending well with rich, red coat color. Strong topline he holds while moving, full body, nicely sprung ribbing, lovely underline with nice tuck up, even at 6 years old. Beautiful strong feeling bone but not overdone. Excellent feet with just a slight tipping of white on front toes. Well up on leg with wonderful front to rear balance. Front well placed, good shoulder & upper arm, great forechest. Moderate rear angulation. Skin pliant but coat a bit heavy & substantial undercoat. I would also prefer a bit longer neck, but it does have an arch. Pigment strong. Tail could be higher set it has a gentle curve, no curl. It wags freely. Temperament seems very stable. He was discerning upon our meeting but accepting in a short time. Holds his strong back when moving, very sound going away, sound enough moving toward you- just a tiny "off" moving feet but getting quite happy. Smooth, efficient, easy gait. Because of tail and coat I must use the "good" category but I feel this dog has some outstanding features to be added to a breeding program.

## **AKC Approved Basenji-Breeder Judge -- Marianne Klinkowski on March 26, 2011**

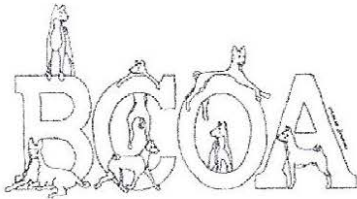

He has good skull to muzzle proportion, small, high set ears, wrinkle when alert, dark eyes, black nose and a foxy little face. He is moderately angulated with equal of shoulder & upper arm. His movement is light and springy from the side and he is sound coming and going. His tail is low set and carried up over his back when alert. His temperament is alert and cautious but calm and he is friendly when he gets to know you. "Kudo" is a basenji of the old school and I believe he has a lot to offer the breed.

Correct standard sized red/white dog @ 17 X 17. Beautiful bone and feet. Has required white on all four feet although just barely. White chest and belly. Tail tip physically missing. Head very foxy and well planed and chiseled. Muzzle slightly shorter than foreface. Could use more cushioning. Eyes slightly rounded but nice dark color. Could use darker pigment although has extremely red coat may give illusion of lighter contrast. Ears well set & small. Coat very dark chestnut. Slightly thick but time of year (Fall) may come into play. Has visible wrinkle. Moderately angled in the rear. Decent shoulders although slightly straight and set toward neck. Equal proportions of shoulder blade to upper arm. Topline has a dip behind shoulders and slightly rounded croup with slight dropoff at tail. Tail set okay but carries straight. Might have been traumatized at an early age since tip missing. Movement typical. Good rear. Little narrow in front. Appears friendly and affable. Slightly cautious.

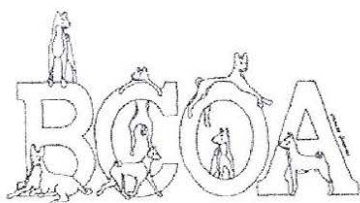

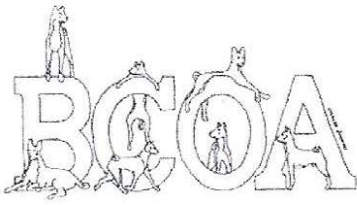
