Her neck set is proper. When stacked and in moving she places her feet in the way I like to see a basenji do.

Her temperament was very good. She did stand for exam and would come up to me on the ground.

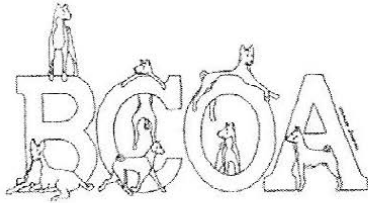
In my opinion she should be added to the breeding stock.

Peanut has an outgoing, sweet and happy temperament. Peanut's overall appearance is sturdy and robust with strong bone structure, deep brisket and the needed spring of rib, to do the job that she was bred to do. I wouldn't question her ability to hunt all day and be ready for more the following day. Peanut is a plainly marked red and white female with a small blaze and small white collar on her left side. She also has interesting white pips or what appear to be white/lemon pips over each eye. Those pips really enhance her dark eye rims and the shape of her eyes. Peanut's skin is correct and very pliant. She is sturdy, yet still a lightly built girl of proper 16" size at the wither. She has that lovely quizzical expression and an acceptable amount of wrinkling, when her ears are erect. Peanut's ears are shaped very well and nicely hooded, both which are so desirable in our breed. As mentioned above, her eye rims are dark and the shapes of her eyes correct. I would like to see a touch bit darker eye, but they certainly wouldn't be considered light in color. Her eye shape and set give that "far-seeing" expression; that the breed standard calls for, also. Peanut's head shape is a bit masculine, but planes, cushion, cheekiness and ratios are correct and without question, Basenji. Peanut's bite is aligned well, but there is one tooth just under the top row of teeth that prevents it from being a correct scissors bite. Her neck is well set, correct length and well set into her shoulders. Her neck has correct amount of crest, as well as the proper fullness at the base of her throat. Topline is straight and correct with her overall length of body being longer the she is tall. Peanut's shoulder assembly is correct, well angulated and good layback. Her has correct amount of angulation and nicely muscled, though a bit cow-hocked when standing and moving. Peanut has very correct feet that are well shaped with strong pasterns and a correct arch to her toes. Tail curls over back in one large curl wit the set being less than call for by breed standard.

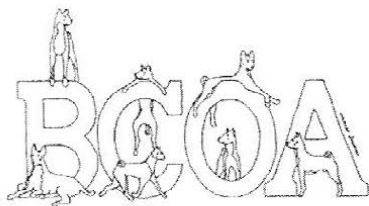

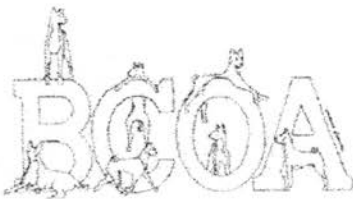

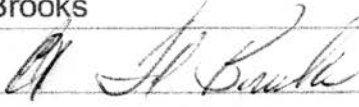
